**RULING**

**Introduction.**

Kalemeera Henry (herein after referred to as the applicant) was charged before the General Court martial for the offence of illegal possession of firearms contrary to section 4(1)(2)(a)(3)(4) of the Firearms Act Cap 320 and was remanded at Kigo main government prison.

He lodged an application for bail before this Honourable Court by way of a notice of motion supported by his affidavit for orders that he be released on bail pending his trial and costs of the application.

**Legal representation**

The applicant was represented by learned counsel Nsubuga Simon of Ssemengo and Co. Advocates and the respondent was represented by learned senior state attorney Kamusiime Shallote from the office of the director of public prosecutions.

**Consideration.**

When this application came up for hearing on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May 2026, counsel for the applicant submitted that the matter had been overtaken by events for reason that since the filing of this application, the applicant was charged before the General Court Martial where a substantive bail application has since been lodged and is pending determination and therefore, the applicant is no longer interested in pursuing the application before this court and consequently prayed to withdraw the same.

The respondent on the other hand did not object to the prayer of the applicant to withdraw the application.



Since the application for withdrawal was not opposed, I hereby strike out the said application by reason of withdrawal.
